- Bluebird Box/Aviary Construction:** I would like to build my own nest box (we can provide plans for you) or assist in box-building or aviary-building gatherings.
- Nest Box Placers:** Place bluebird boxes on approved sites for those landowners who are unable to.
- Bluebird Watcher:** Keen eyes and good birding skills needed here. As we will not be radio-tracking released bluebirds, we will need to visually track where they disperse to, and help determine if any have taken up residence in nest boxes.
Timeframe: approx. March-July
- Nest Box Monitor:** Monitors needed to check nest boxes where the landowner will not be able to. Boxes should be monitored from late March to early July once a week to check for occupancy; once occupancy established, closely monitor (every 2-3 days) nesting pairs and report on behavior.
